After lectures and demonstrations in Zürich during the first two days of the Blockkurs, the excursion to institutions and field sites in Argentina aims to developing an understanding of the evolution of biotic communities in South America. Emphasis will be on the terrestrial animal communities north of Patagonia from the last 10 million years (late Miocene-Recent). Diverse geological formations will be examined, while collecting and identifying fossils, mostly vertebrates. Activities include visits to museum and zoo in Buenos Aires and La Plata, four full days of fieldwork in Mendoza (camping, rough conditions), visit to smaller museums and archeological sites, and a one day of geological trip to the foot of the Andes.

Requested student activities will involve a talk, demonstration following a short practical project, processing, identification and cataloguing of palaeontological samples. This practical course is aimed at Bachelor students with special interest in palaeontology and/or organismal biology and likely aiming at conducting Master work in some area Evolutionary Biology.

Prerequisites: BIO 121, other course(s) in one or all of these disciplines: Zoology / Evolution / Palaeontology.

Costs CHF 2300 per person, to help cover international and local airfares, transport to and from airports, hotels, field vehicles, excursions, and most meals. The research lab will subsidize the rest of the many other costs. Own insurance arrangements will be required.
